





#### **Our Vision**



To actively stimulate and harness the **dormant force** of African agricultural professionals in the diaspora and direct their vast varied resources towards Africa's agricultural development




# **AAAPD: Long-term Expectations**

# **Support for Training in Research**


#### Diaspora scientists will:







### **Assumptions**




- Long- and Short-term sabbaticals, mentorship, contract leave
