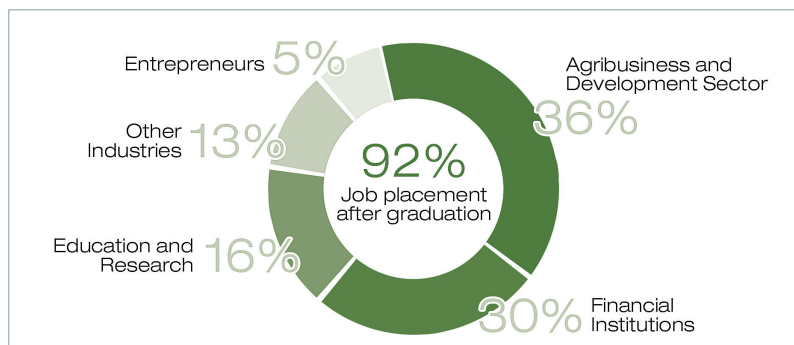

Admission Criteria

The applicants will be screened based on their academic background and then invited for an interview. Shortlisted applicants will be offered preparatory summer courses in Economics and Business Statistics. Based on application and academic performance in summer courses, the final selection of students will be made.
