- Working with 12 AET institutions
- Goal: Increase the agricultural productivity in Senegal by improving the quality of AET

Lessons from the ERA Project

- WFD/HICD work is hard
- The Human Capacity Development must progress at the same pace and with the same focus as the Institutional Capacity Development activities.
 - A recently trained individual becomes “disenchanted” when the institution is not ready to accept the ideas presented in training
 - Institutional develop (internal policy change) requires local actors to make the institutional development “stick”
