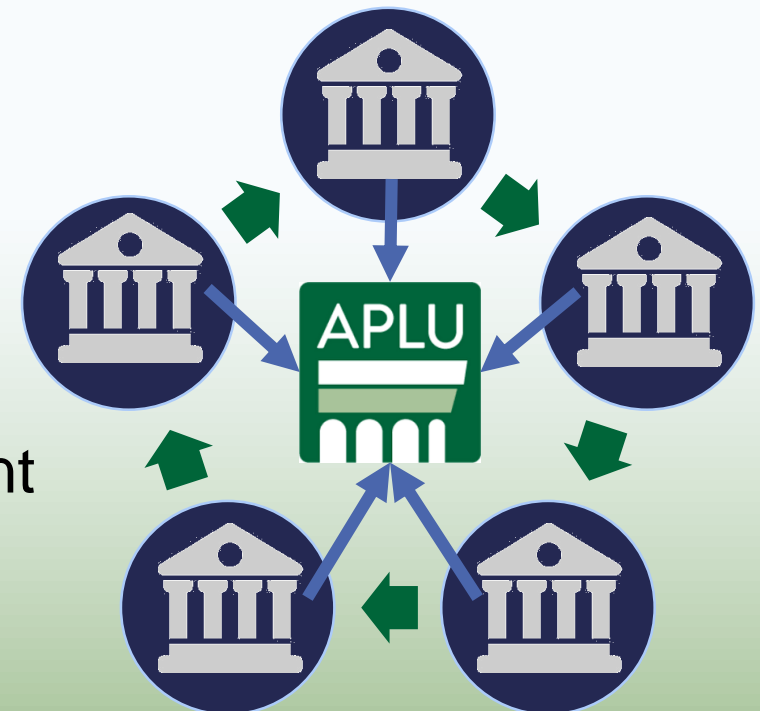

# La Prévention est Vitale!

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Institutional practices and policies are a necessary but insufficient starting point to address sexual harassment.

A growing body of research indicates that prevention education is the most effective method for decreasing incidents of sexual harassment and violence. In particular, university leaders should consider these evidence-based strategies:

- By-Stander Intervention Programing  
Intervention des Spectateurs
- Increasing access to Community Partners  
Accès aux Services Communautaires
- Institutional Response Teams (often called SARTs in U.S.)
